

Logging Into Moodle

There are two possible ways to log into Moodle:

- 1. You may log in from a **You are not logged in** page.
- 2. You may use a Login block.

Logging in from the "You Are Not Logged in" Page

Access your school's Moodle page and locate the **You are not logged in. (Login)** hyperlink; this link is typically in the top right-hand corner. Click the hyperlink.
