| Goals for treatment | Goals for treatment are clearly defined using SMART Goals. (25 points) | Goals for treatment are not clear; SMART model not used. (15 points) | There are no identified goals for treatment. (0 points) |
| Family Involvement | The student clearly identifies which family members will be a part of treatment and rationale is provided. (10 points) | The student does not clearly identify who will be a part of treatment. Rationale is unclear or not completed. (5 points) | The student does not identify who will be a part of treatment. Rationale is not provided. (0 points) |
| Intervention | The student provides a clear explanation of their strategy for working with the family. Specific techniques are described in the paper. (40 points) | The student provides an unclear explanation of their strategy for working with the family. Specific techniques are not discussed within the paper. (25 points) | The student does not provide an explanation of their strategy for working with the family. (0 points) |
